MAPFRE PREMIUMS GROW 7% TO SEPTEMBER

- The company gives advance information to the market regarding premiums by region and business unit
- In IBERIA, premiums grew 7.4%, surpassing 5.7 billion euros
- MAPFRE RE premiums increase 11.7%

MAPFRE has decided to release advance information to the market about premiums by region and business unit. This is part of our commitment to transparency and it allows the public to follow the behavior of the key business indicator a few days ahead of the approval and publication of results, which is planned for October 29 for this quarter.

This information makes it possible to provide a more complete understanding of the Group business performance, since some countries release information about MAPFRE's written premiums to September 30 in advance of the results presentation.
